 The latch mechanism works in the exact same way as the ITD1348 latch works, but in addition to the front latching mechanism, you also have a cradle on the rear of the mount where you may place your dolly break over bar, and one of your dollies axles.

• If you have an axle placed inside the Integrated Speed Mount, you must always have a dolly placed inside the cradle, as well as the latch door in the closed & locked position before traveling.

 To secure a dolly break-over bar inside the integrated speed mount. place it into the channel at the back of the mount, and tighten the securement knobs. Fig. 5-A, 5-B, & 5-C

MOUNTING

CHECK FITMENT 2

In order to properly install the Dolly Box, the front edge of the mount, must be flush with the edge of the toolbox. Fig. 2

DRILL HOLES 3

Mark the spots where you want to drill the hole for mounting your box, and drill them out. (Refer to measurements listed above.)

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
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



ASSEMBLY

(4) ASSEMBLE BEARINGS

Use the lists located inside *Fig.* **3** and *Fig.* **4** to assemble and install the bearings used to slide the drawer of the dolly box out and in.

(5) INSTALL DUST COVERS

Use 5/16"-18 X1" Button head screws to attach the dust covers to the sides of the Dolly Box. Use locktite when tightening to make sure they don't vibrate lose as you're traveling down the road. *Fig.* **5**

6) LATCH ADJUSTMENT

Leave 1/16" Gap between Latch & Striker. Fig. 6

CORRECT MOUNTING ORIENTATION 1

Make sure when installing your Universal Dolly Mount, that you pay attention to the orientation of the Dollies, Axles, and Break-Over Bar. The dolly should always be facing outward towards the edge of the deck, and the latch should be on the cab side of the mount. Due to variances in manufacturers' wrecker bodies, truck bodies and mounting surfaces, ITD cannot provide explicit mounting requirements for every mounting option. These instructions are to serve only as a guideline. Final installation requirements are left to the discretion of a qualified installer.

MOUNTING

RECOMMENDED HARDWARE (NOT INCLUDED)

- 14 5/16" Bolts (Grade 5 or better)
- 14 5/16" Nuts (Grade 5 or better)
- 28 5/16" Washers

(1) dolly bunk placement

Determine the width the bunk sides need to be spaced. Take overall width of dolly and add 1/2" for clearance. *Fig. 1*

2) MARK MOUNTING HOLES

- Layout bottom of toolbox.
- Create centerline for dolly placement.
- Mark a line 1/2" the required distance for proper dolly spacing, either side of the "centerline" *Fig.* 2

3 BOLT TO BOX


Bolt each side to tool box using a minimum of 3x 5/16" bolts, 6x 5/16" washers, & 3x 5/16" nuts. *Fig. 2a*

4 MOUNT LOCKING SECTION

Mark and bolt center locking section on centerline of toolbox. Mount locking section rearward so that it holds dolly to the back of mount, with minimum slack in the chain. *Fig. 2b*

LOCKING NOTE

To lock dolly use supplied safety chain to wrap around dolly tube. Then feed free end of chain through round portion of key *Fig. 3 & Fig. 4*



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ASSEMBLY

Carrier Dolly Mount is sold as each. You will need 2 ITD1347 Carrier Dolly Mounts to hold a set of standard Dollies. The latch is on the right hand side of the operator as he or she faces the mount. The latch comes pre-assembled.

ASSEMBLY HARDWARE (INCLUDED)

- 10 5/16" x 3/4" Bolts
- 20 5/16" Washers
- 10 5/16" Acorn Nuts
- 8 1/4" Washers
- 4 1¼ Bolts
- 4 1/4" Nuts
- 4 Spacers

1 ATTACH RIGHT & LEFT SIDES

Attach left and right tire bunks to the steel weldment using 5/16" bolts, washers, and acorn nuts. Recommended torque of 25 ft. lbs. The holes are slotted in both directions to allow the optimum fitment for the Dolly. Bolts should be firmly tightened. NOTE: Bolts should be checked after 4-5 uses to confirm tightness is adequate. *Fig. 1 & Fig. 2*


2) INSTALL HEAT SHIELD


Install heat shield with aluminum spacers using included 1/4" hardware. The heat shield is intended to help protect the Dolly tires from heat created from the vehicles exhaust system. The aluminum spacers are to be installed between the heat shield and tire bunk weldments. *Fig.* **3**



4 - 1/2" Grade 5 Bolts

•Four 1/2" Grade 5 bolts at a minimum are recommended for proper installation. (Installation hardware not included.) *Fig. 4*

1 BOLT TO FRAME

• Using at a minimum 4 - 1/2" grade 5 bolts or higher, mount the dolly mount to the frame of your carrier.

• This device is intended to mount an X-Series[™] XL-SD dolly to the frame of a carrier vehicle, it is not intended for XD dolly storage.

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
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

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
