Limited Warranty

In The Ditch Towing Products (also referred to herein as ITD) warrants to the original purchaser that new ITD manufactured goods will be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of twelve (12) months from the date placed in service. The purchaser must promptly notify ITD in writing of any failure in material or workmanship. In no event shall ITD accept such notification later than twelve (12) months from the date placed in service.

ITD's obligation under this warranty, statutory or otherwise, is limited to the repair or replacement at the ITD factory, or at a point designated by ITD, of such part or parts as shall appear upon inspection by ITD to be defective in material or workmanship. This warranty is not transferable. This warranty does not obligate ITD to bear the cost of labor or transportation charges in connection with the repair or replacement of any part(s) found to be defective, nor shall it apply to a product upon which repairs or alterations have been made unless such repairs or alterations were authorized by ITD.

Except as expressly set forth in this warranty, ITD makes no other warranty, express or implied, and hereby disclaims all other warranties including, but not limited to, the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose. ITD shall in no event be liable for any claims for downtime, loss of profits or goodwill, or any claims for other special, incidental, indirect, or consequential damages concerning or relating to any product or parts, whether based on negligence, strict liability, breach of contract, breach of warranty, misrepresentation, or any other legal theory, regardless of whether the loss resulted from any general or particular requirement which ITD knew or had reason to know about at the time of sale.

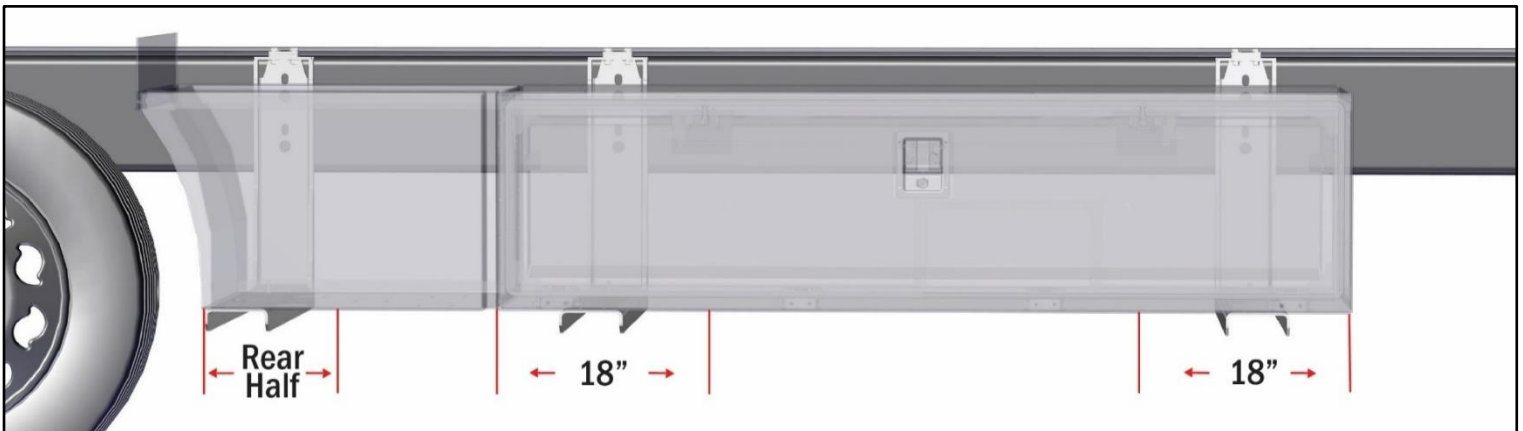
1 Hang Quick™ Mounts

Install Quick™ Mount Hang Tab onto the Quick™ Mount. Hang the Quick™ Mount from the frame rail.



2 Mount Locations

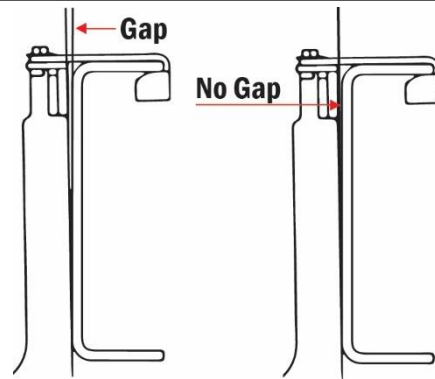
Quick™ Mount must be located within 18" of the ends of each box. Use a minimum of 2 Quick™ Mounts per Pro Series™ Tool Box and 1 for each Storage™ Fender. If you are going to exceed 600lbs. total load limit. We recommend 3 Quick™ Mounts on a Pro Series™ Tool Box.



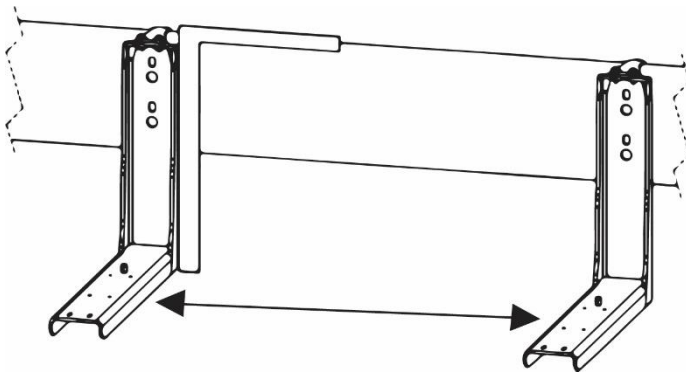

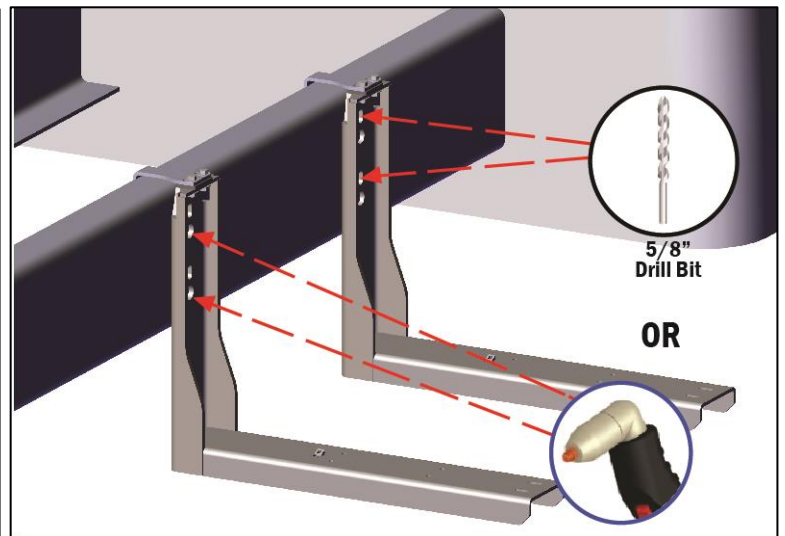
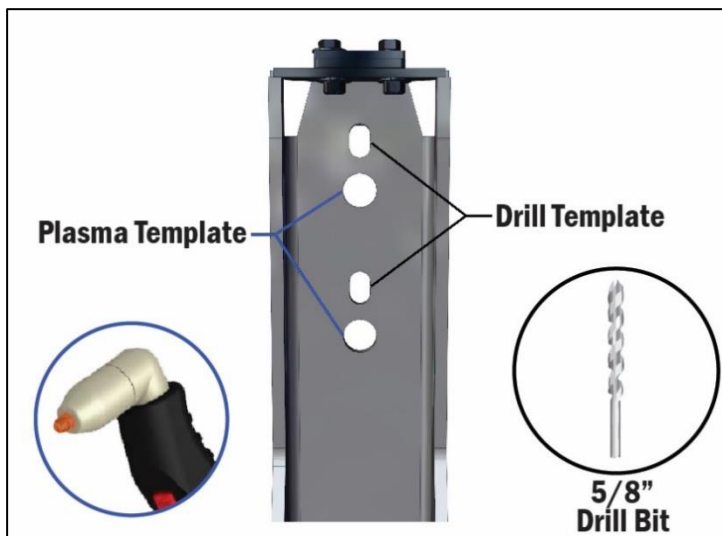


Once mounts are in position, check square with the top of the frame to make sure they are sitting plumb to the truck.

Each mount is rated for 300lb. Toolboxes require a minimum of 2 mounts each. Storage fenders require 1 mount each. Additional mounts may be required, this is up to the discretion of the installer.

5 Mounting Templates

Quick™ Mounts are designed with pre-install mounting templates to plasma cut or drill mounting holes in the truck frame. Use the templates to quickly and easily install the Quick™ Mounts.

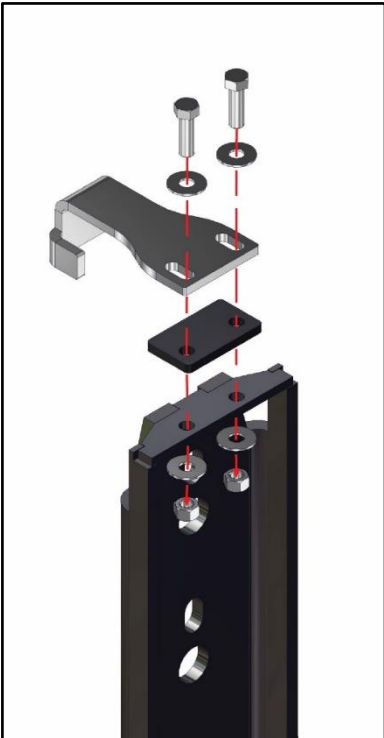
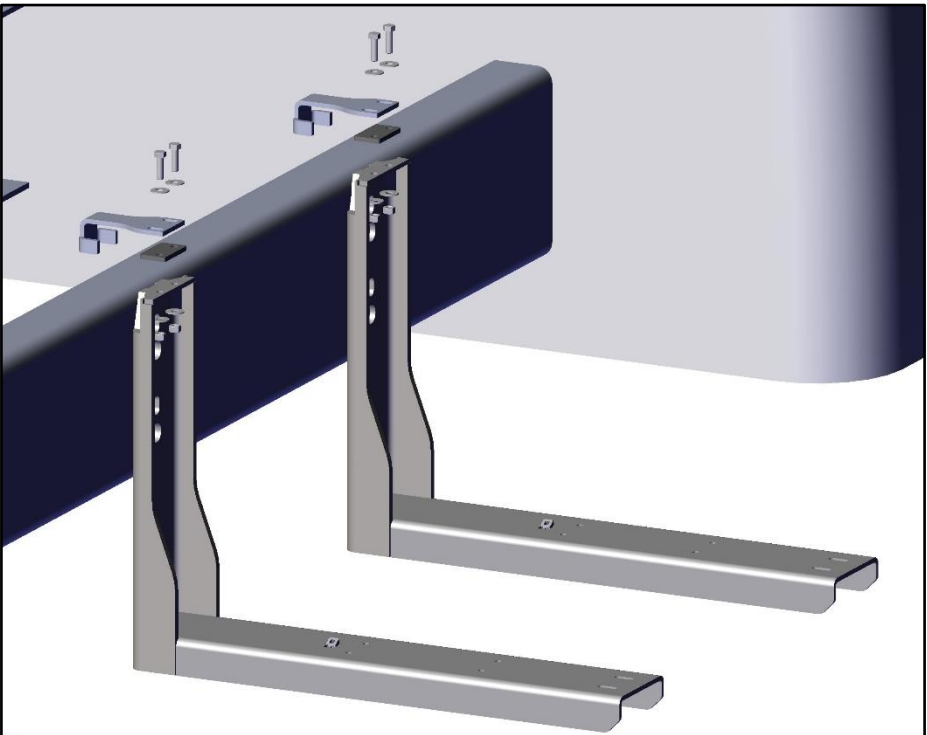


Use minimum of two (2) -5/8" grade 5 bolts to install mount to frame. Bolts must be properly torqued for installation. Mounting hardware **NOT** included.

Remove Quick™ Mounts Hang Tabs

Once the Quick™ Mounts are securely mounted to the frame rail, remove the Quick™ hang Tabs.



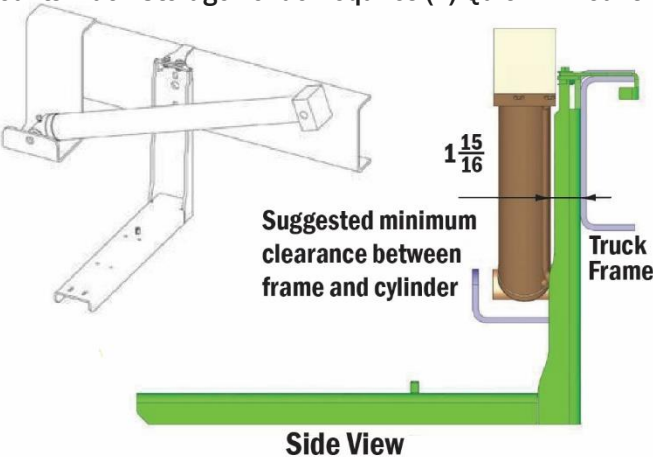

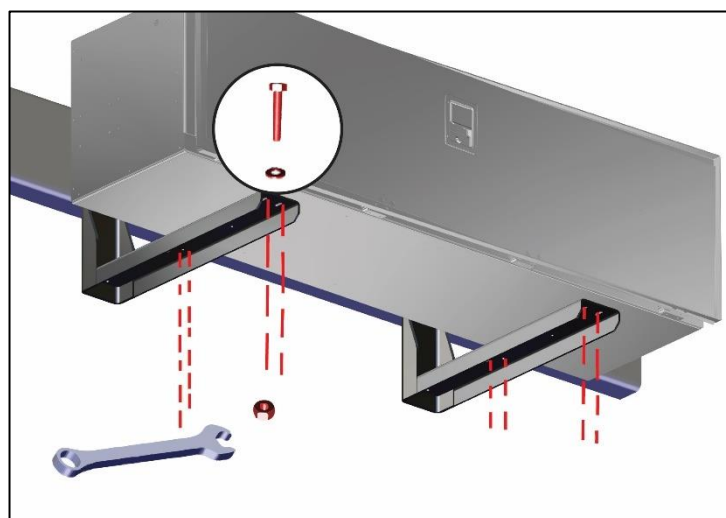
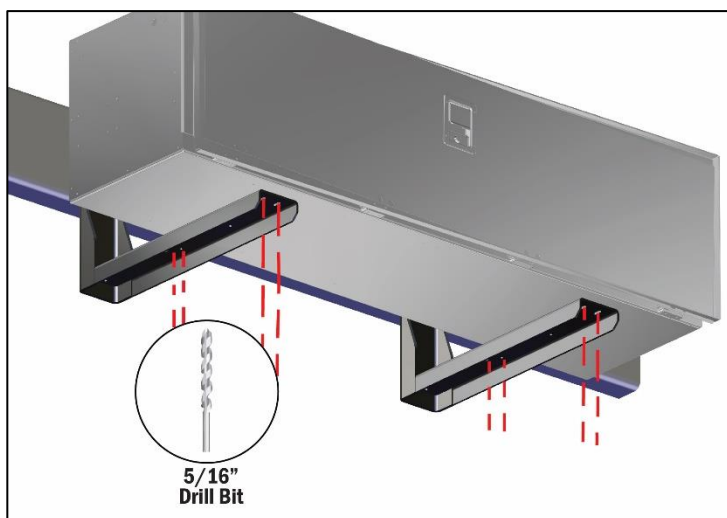
1 Set Pro Series™ Tool Box

Once Set Pro Series™ Tool Box on Quick™ Mounts, make sure to check fore and aft measurements. The stop tab is used to quickly align tool box. If you want to set tool box in closer to the frame, simply bend stop tab down with a hammer.



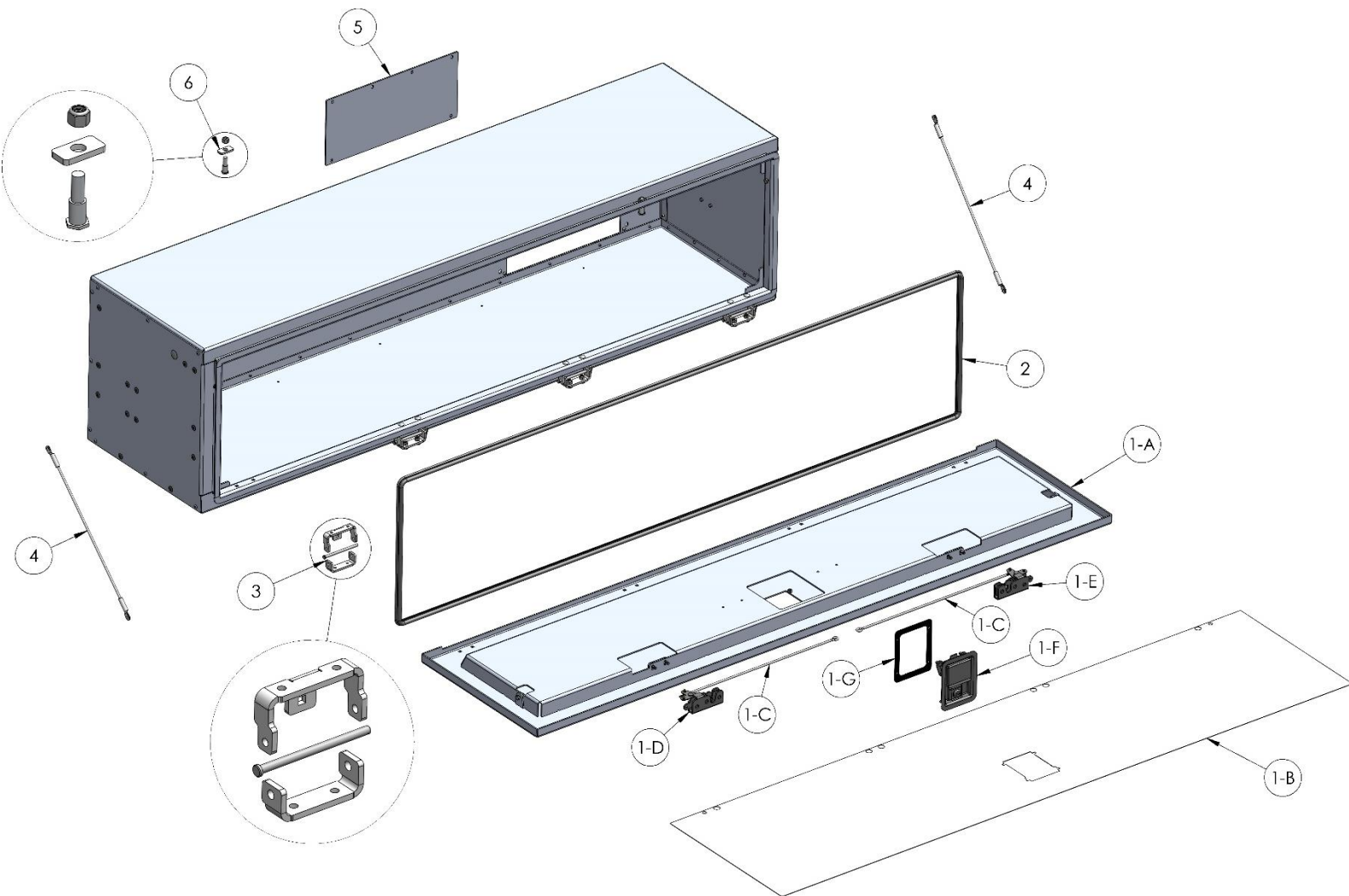
2 Drill & Bolt Pro Series™ Tool Box

Drill four 5/16" holes through the tool box per Quick™ Mount, two in the front and two in rear of box. When mounting Pro Series™ Tool Box on Quick Mounts, it is recommended to use a minimum of eight 5/16" flanged hex nuts and bolts.

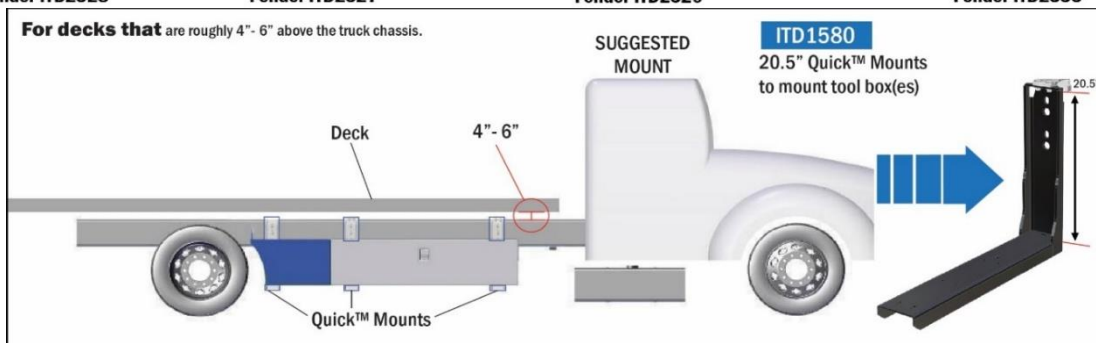
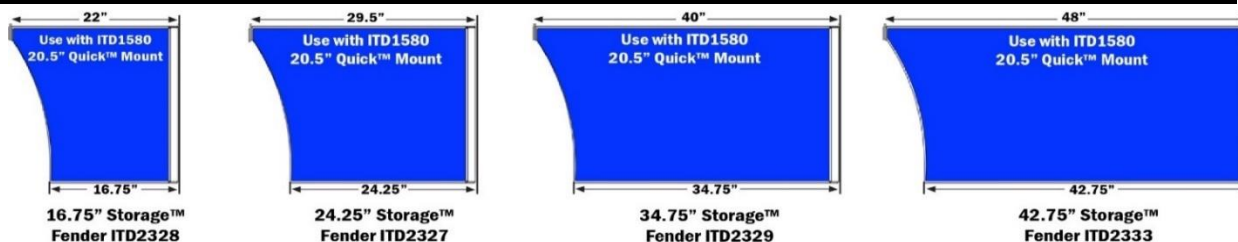


Storage™ Fender Measurement Diagram

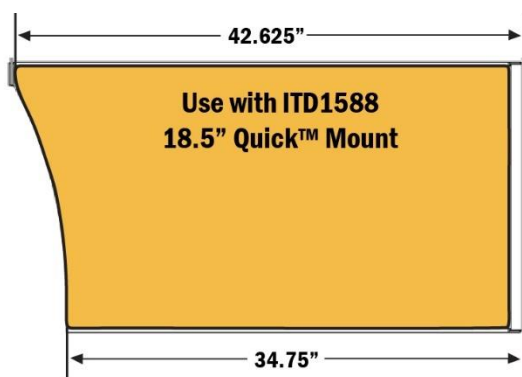
